



# Pack 1491 Cake Bake & Auction

The cake bake is an opportunity for each Scout to participate in a fun baking activity with his father or other guiding male adult and raise funds for the Pack. The Scout theme for October is *Space: The Final Frontier.*

## *Cake Bake & Auction Rules*

- Cakes must be registered at the school cafeteria between 6:30-6:45 PM Monday October 10th. Meeting will start promptly at 6:45.
- Cakes must be baked by the Scout and older male (father, grandfather, uncle, older brother, neighbor) where ever possible
- Store-bought completed cakes are not permitted but cake mixes and icing mixes may be used
- Creations must be edible. The use of non-edible decorations is permitted
- Cakes should be placed on a tray or cardboard foundation that can be given away with the cake
- You have to decide to buy back your cake at the time of registration; you will not be able to buy back a cake once the auction has begun. In addition, if you bring one cake and buy that cake back, then your boy will not be given a paddle and will not be permitted to participate in the auction. If you do not bring a cake to be put into the auction, then your boy will not be given a paddle and will not be permitted to participate in the auction (remember your cake!).
- The fee to buy back your cake is \$10.00. The minimum bid for a cake is \$10.00.
- The maximum number of cakes a boy can bring is 2. If a boy brings 2 cakes, at least one must be a buy back and only one can be placed in the auction. If both cakes are buy backs, then the buy back rule above applies.
- For the auction process, once a boy has won the bid on a cake, his paddle will be collected so he will not be able to bid on future cakes.
- Scouts will vote for their favorite cake. Ribbons will be awarded for the Top 3 Scout choices. Other ribbons will be awarded as judged by the Den Leaders, the categories are listed below.
- The Ribbons will be awarded at the November Pack meeting
- To ensure impartial judging, scout names should not be shown on the cake (upon registration each cake will be given a number), however, each scout should name their cake**
- Most importantly.....bring your money/checks!! **All cakes must be paid for before leaving the cafeteria.**

### **All cakes will be judged and ribbons awarded for:**

Most Original looking	Highest Bid Cake	Best Effort
Yummiest Looking	Most Disgusting	Biggest Cake
Best "Space" Theme	Best Halloween Cake	Best "Cub Scout" Theme

Each Scout participating in the Cake Bake will receive a patch. Bidding will take place as part of our October Pack Meeting activity. Parents will be responsible for children placing bids, so please discuss this with your children ahead of time (or make sure you maintain "eye contact"!)
