

PACK 1491's Year End Trip Details

Camping on the USS YORKTOWN at PATRIOTS POINT

When: March 25-27, 2011

Where: 40 Patriots Point Road Mount Pleasant, SC 29464 (Charleston Harbor)

Cost: **\$80 per person**, all siblings must be 6 years of age to attend. This includes 3 meals on Saturday and breakfast on Sunday morning.

Deadline for registration and payment: Pack 1491's January 24, 2011 Meeting

Important Information For All Attending:

- Meals are served "Navy" fashion in the Chief Petty Officers' Mess.
- No carry-on food or drinks will be allowed. A snack bar and vending machines are available in addition to scheduled meals.
- All campers are assigned specific berthing quarters and are requested to respect the privacy of other campers by not entering any other berthing quarters. The berthing quarters are heated and air-conditioned. ****PLEASE NOTE-DUE TO THE CONFIGURATION OF BERTHING COMPARTMENTS AND THE NATURE OF THE PROGRAM, THERE ARE NO MULTIGENDER CAMPING AREAS. MALES MUST CAMP IN THE AREAS ASSIGNED FOR THEIR MALE CAMPERS AND FEMALES MUST CAMP IN THE AREAS ASSIGNED TO THEIR FEMALE CAMPERS-NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- Because of the fire code and as stated in a letter received from the State Fire Marshal's office, "It is required that all persons sleeping onboard participate in a fire drill and physically traverse the escape route." To meet these requirements, all campers and adults must be **onboard** by 8:30 p.m., with no exceptions. We regret that those individuals who cannot meet these requirements may not camp onboard. **Importance of arriving as a group:** Everyone attending with PACK 1491 should arrive at Patriots Point parking lot no later than 8pm on Friday, March 25, 2011. Due to the nature of our Orientation Program, Pack 1491 **must** enter the ship simultaneously as a group.
- **Each person must bring a sleeping bag, pillow, shampoo, deodorant, toothpaste, soap, towel, wash cloth and all other necessary personal effects. Insect repellent is advisable.** Troops are required to carry all luggage from the parking area down the 600-foot pier to the Yorktown. Please pack with this in mind.
- Patriots Point Camp Safety policy restricts campers to ages six and above. Campers 6-Wolf must be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult. Web 1 & 2 campers must have a group adult leader and one chaperone per every 10 campers. Female leaders must be responsible for female participants and male leaders for male participants.
